Mary B. McCarthy, 70 years, of Hamburg, NJ., passed away at home with her family by her side on Thursday, October 12, 2017.

She was born on June 21, 1947 in Forty fort, PA to the late Genevieve Ann (nee Munley) Collins and the late Thomas Francis Collins.
