



## ALFRED SOROKACH

January 20, 1937 - December 31, 2012

Alfred V. Sorokach, 75, of Oak ridge, passed away on Monday, January 31, 2012. He was born in Passaic, NJ to Rose (nee Szmagalski) and Alexander Sorokach. Mr. Sorokach proudly served in the US Air Force on active duty from 1958 and retired as a Major in 1964. He continued in the Air National Guard reserves for the next 20 years.
