Angela Theresa Feldmann (née Petracco), beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister, teacher, and friend, passed away peacefully on October

Born in Paterson, New Jersey, on January 6, 1944, Angela was the daughter of the late Frank and Theresa (Cerutti) Petracco.

She graduated from Eastside High School in 1961 and went on to earn her degree from Paterson State College (now William Paterson University) in 1965.

On August 14, 1965, Angela married the love of her life, Robert Feldmann. Together they shared 57 years of marriage before Robert's passing in December 2022. The couple first made their home in Little Falls before moving to Oak Ridge in 1968, where they raised their family and created a lifetime of cherished memories at 8 Windsor Drive.

Angela began her teaching career at Washington Park School in Totowa Boro before joining the staff at Jefferson Township Middle School, where she taught English from 1980 until her retirement in 2006. A gifted educator, she inspired generations of students with her love of language, literature, and learning. She was an avid Yankees and Giants fan who brought the same energy and loyalty to cheering on her teams as she did to supporting her loved ones. But above all, Angela's heart belonged to her family. She was the glue that held everyone together—steady, loving, and endlessly giving.
