Bernice Catherine "Penny" Sorokach, 84, of Oak Ridge, New Jersey, passed away on Monday June 19, 2023.

Born on September 3, 1938 in Brooklyn, New York to the late Camillus (nee Donnelly) and the late Michael J. Cryne.

She married Alfred V. Sorokach, a young Air Force Officer, in 1960, and together they raised their five boys.

Penny was an Air Force wife. She spent her life in selfless service to her family, church, community, and country.

Mrs. Sorokach worked as a Kindergarten and pre-first teacher at White Rock and Milton Elementary Schools in Jefferson for over 25 years until her retirement in 1998.

Penny was a parishioner for many years at St. Thomas the Apostle R.C. Church in Oak Ridge. and volunteered much of her time with the Milton First Aid Squad, also in Milton as well as the Jefferson Arts Committee.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Alfred V. Sorokach in 2012, her son Daniel Sorokach of Redfield, New York in 2021 and her brother Michael J. Cryne.

Penny is survived by four of her five sons, Alexander Sorokach and his wife

Denise of Colorado; John Sorokach and Simone of Tempe, Arizona; Dave Sorokach of Colorado and Joe Sorokach and his wife Cindy of Phoenix, Arizona; her six granddaughters, Annalee of South Carolina and Catherine of Arizona, Karen and Alexandra of Colorado, and Helen and Eva of Arizona; and her brother Robert F. Cryne of Nebraska.

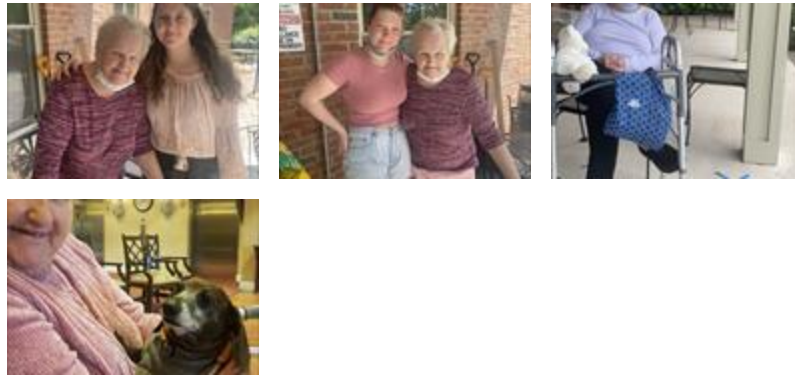
