Catherine "Cathy" Cahir died peacefully at home on November 3rd in West Milford, NJ at the age of 84.

Cathy was born on January 22, 1939, in the Bronx, New York to Catherine and Thomas Fitzpatrick. She graduated business school in 1958 and married the love of her life, Michael, on May 27, 1961. Over their 49 years of marriage, Cathy and Michael welcomed 7 children into their home, moving to Palisades, NY and Teaneck, NJ, before ultimately buying their home in West Milford, NJ in 1967.

Cathy worked for the West Milford Board of Education for over 30 years as Head Cook at Marshall Hill School and Maple Road School before retiring. In her free time, Cathy enjoyed attending service at Our Lady Queen of Peace.

Cathy was adored by her family, friends, and many grandchildren: Bobby, Tony, Kelly, Tara; Dillon; David, Kyle, Kel, and Nik (2020); Allyssa and Shannon; and Anna. She is remembered as a kind, gentle, and loving person/mother who would always put others before herself.

She was preceded in death by her husband Michael in 2010, her son Sean in 1976, her sister Margaret Dempsey in 2022, and her grandson Nicholas "Nik" in 2020.

Cathy is survived by her brothers James and John Fitzpatrick; her daughters Kathleen, Maureen, and Colleen; and sons Michael, David, and Matthew.
