Christopher R. Woop, 48 years, of Oak Ridge, NJ, passed away on Saturday, July 15, 2017.

He was born on May 1, 1969 in the Bronx, NY to Judith (nee O'Rourke) and the late Robert Woop.

Chris was raised in Butler, NJ and graduated from Butler High School in 1987 where he was the Captain of the Ski Team.

For the last 30 years he was the owner of Woop Brothers landscaping business and was self-proclaimed as the fastest brick layer in New Jersey.

He will best be remembered for his quick wit, love of riding motorcycles, but

most of all for his hard and strong work ethic along with his attention to detail. He was predeceased by his beloved father Robert in 1999.

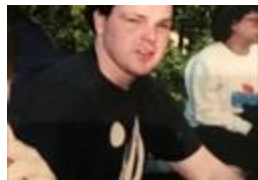

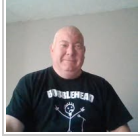
