Additionally, he was an amazing poet and songwriter. Dale was a multifaceted man of many, many talents, and will be sorely missed by all who knew him – because to know him was to love him.

Dale inherited his writing skills from his mother, and although she preceded him in death, her words written in the following poem expressed the deep bond and love only a mother can have:
