Frank A. Maddaloni, 76 years old, passed away February 20, 2020, surrounded by his loving family. He was born August 31, 1943, in Brooklyn NY to the late Frank Sr. & Rose Maddaloni.

Frank dedicated his entire life to God, his family, and his community. He lived the last 50 years in Rockaway Township, where he served the town as Mayor, Council President and Councilmen. He dedicated his time to St. Cecilia Church in Rockaway, serving as Eucharistic Minister, Youth Group Leader, Marriage Encounter and Antioch Programs. He also sang in the Church Choir, with his adoring wife Adeline Maddaloni, predeceased 2016.

He held a Bachelor's Degree in Business and Economics from St. Francis College, Brooklyn, NY. He was an avid reader, a trivia champ; loved sports, music, singing and politics, but nothing was more important than spending time with his family.

Frank spent most of his career as a Stock Broker for Dean Witter, DLJ Direct,

and Merrill Lynch. After a career change to corporate training, he later retired from Benjamin Moore in 2009.

Beyond his many accomplishments, Frank shared a beautiful bond of love with his children: son Frank T. Maddaloni of Rockaway, and daughter Janice Hayeck and her husband Ron of Succasunna, NJ. Frank cherished his beautiful grandchildren, Tia and Mario Maddaloni, and Dylan and Tori Hayeck. They will remember their 'Poppy,' who devoted his life to each of them.
