



FRITZ WECKENMANN

Fritz Weckenmann, 79, of Oak Ridge, passed away at his home on Thursday, September 12, 2013.

He was born in Dormettingen, Germany and immigrated to the US in 1953, and he later proudly served in the US Army from 1955-1957.

Mr. Weckenmann married Elisabeth in 1962 and together they raised their two daughters in Oak Ridge, NJ.

He was a faithful parishioner at St. Thomas the Apostle RC Church in Oak Ridge, NJ, and a dedicated member of the American Legion Post 423 in Oak Ridge.
