Gary Schilling, 75 years of age, of Milton, NJ, passed away on Wednesday,
September 7, 2022.

He was born on December 23, 1946 in Elizabeth, NJ to the late Charlotte (nee

Plank) and the late Charles Schilling, II.

Gary married Linda Amerspek in 1972 and resided in Milton, NJ, where they have been longtime residents and where they raised their two daughters.

For more than 35 years Gary worked for ESCO Products as management, and for 16 years he was the Production Manager at Thor Labs in Newton, NJ.

In the 1970's, Gary volunteered for the Civil Defense Auxiliary Police in Jefferson Twp, NJ, which was led by his family. The Schilling family actively began to recruit women to join the Civil Defense Auxiliary Police.

He will best be remembered for his love of fishing, but especially for his love and dedication of family: his wife, daughters, and grandchildren.

Gary was predeceased by his loving parents Charlotte and Charles Schilling, and his dear brother Charles Schilling, III.

He is survived by his beloved wife Linda of 50 years; his devoted daughters Jennifer and Melissa Schilling; his cherished grandchildren Lila, Greyson, and Collin; his dear siblings Candis Meloskie of Bluffton, South Carolina and Lawrence Schilling of Murrietta, California; as well as many nieces and nephews.
