Dr. James "Jim" F. Gleeson, 90 years of age, of the White Lake section of Oak Ridge, New Jersey, passed away on Sunday, October 24, 2021.

He was born on February 15, 1931 in Jersey City, New Jersey to the late Mary (nee Reidy) and James F. Gleeson.

Jim attended the local schools and graduated with a B.S. degree from St. Peter's College in 1952. He proudly served for three years in the US Army overseas in a sensitive position with a Top Secret clearance.

He met his wife Rosina in London where they were married in 1954. After returning to the US, Jim became a teacher in the Kearney, New Jersey school system where he became District Director of Tests and Measurements. He went on to receive a Master's Degree from Seton Hall University and a Doctorate from Rutgers University. He joined the West Milford Township public school system where he served as Supervisor of Instruction, Business Administrator and Superintendent of Schools. He joined Passaic County Tech in 1977 as Superintendent and Business Administrator.

Jim also served numerous years as the head of educational services at Greystone Hospital while also running a successful service business, Rullo & Gleeson Associates.

Jim was a member of numerous professional organizations. He has contributed time to civic causes by serving on an Adult School Board of Directors, Library Board of Directors, Township Zoning Board of Adjustment and Township Planning Board.

He has served on the Board of Directors of N.J. Cystic Fibrosis for three years as Secretary and Vice President.

Jim was an active member of St. Thomas the Apostle Church for 50 years, serving countless charities and organizations.

Jim is survived by his beloved wife Rosina, his loving children Jimmy and his wife Patricia, Cathy and her husband Gene, Rosemary and her husband Jerry, Paul and his wife Teri, and Robert and his wife Dania; his 12 cherished grandchildren Cheryl, Joe, Jim and his wife Claire, Christopher and his fiancée Dominique, Brittany and her husband Daniel, Daniel, Carly, Matthew, Jenny, R.J., Sara, and Brian; and his adored great grandchildren Aiden, Owen, and soon to be born Hunter.

We will greatly miss his unique sense of humor, generosity, wisdom and unconditional love.
