Jean Virginia Elizabeth Dillon Fitzmaurice, 92 Years of age, of Jefferson Township, New Jersey, passed away at her home on Tuesday, April 6, 2021.

She was born on August 20, 1928 in Brooklyn, New York to the late Mary (nee Morris) and the late Thomas F. Dillon, Sr.

Jean married George J. Fitzmaurice in 1948 and resided in Paterson and later moved to Milton, New Jersey where they raised their family.

She is survived by her loving son Brian George Fitzmaurice of Mt.
