Jimmy D. Perry, 72 years, of Oak Ridge, NJ, passed away on Wednesday, June 12, 2019.

Born on June 26, 1946 in Gulfport, Mississippi to the late Marie (Ford) and the late William M. Perry.

He proudly served in the US Marine Corps from 1963 to 1965, 6th Marine

Division.

Jim married Nancy Brown in 1988 at the Handsboro Presbyterian Church in Gulfport, Mississippi where they also resided, later moving to Houston, Texas, then to Salisbury, North Carolina where they had their son Sean.
