Joan Castrignano, 64 years, of Oak Ridge, NJ, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 17, 2025 at Holy Name Medical Center in Teaneck, NJ.

In the early 2000's, Joan fulfilled another dream by owning and operating her own dance studio in Oak Ridge, where she inspired countless local students through her love of movement, creativity, and self-expression.

Never one to stop learning or giving, Joan later returned to school to earn her bachelor's degree in education and became an elementary school teacher. She devoted herself wholeheartedly to nurturing young minds, teaching with patience, creativity, and compassion; qualities that defined every part of her life.

Joan's faith and love for others was a guiding light throughout her life. She now rests peacefully in the loving arms of the Lord.

She was predeceased by her beloved parents, Edward Aslund in 1985 and Catherine Aslund in 2007.

Joan is survived by her beloved husband, John E. Castrignano; her cherished children, Vienna Castrignano, John A. 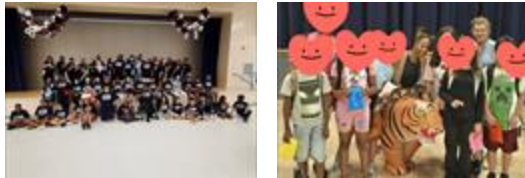

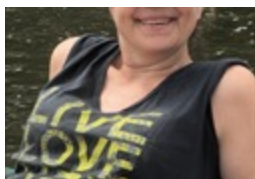
