Joseph M. Wyso, 83, of Oak Ridge, NJ, formerly of New York City and Ridgewood, NJ, went to be with the Lord on Monday, October 12, 2015 surrounded by his family.

Joe was born on December 3, 1931 in New York City to the late Mary (Wojciechowski) and the late Michael Wyso.

Joe proudly served his country in the US Army from 1952 to 1953 in combat during the Korean War (160th Regiment-40th Division).

Joe married Helen A. (Sciara) in 1952 and together they raised their three daughters in Ridgewood, NJ, later moving to Oak Ridge where they have resided for the past 23 years.

Joe was employed throughout his career with Typographical Union #6 in New York City.

He was a member of the American Legion Post 423, Milton; the Korean War Veterans, Chapter 170; the Knights of Columbus Council #5510 in Milton, Oak Ridge and was also a member of the Milton-Oak Ridge Senior Club.
