Kevin W. Toomes, 65 years, of Highland Lakes, NJ, passed away on Thursday, January 25, 2024.

“ I first met Kevin in September of 2006 when I bought the little cabin across the street from him. The first thing I noticed about him was his genuine kindness and acceptance — and the second thing I noticed was his booming voice! He was always a great neighbor, looking out for my house when I wasn’t home, checking in on us during terrible ice storms, and having a great conversation and chuckle when we would meet by the road while checking our respective mailboxes. When Justyna moved up here in 2013, she would tell me she felt safe because Kevin would be home when I was working weekends and she knew she count on him in a pinch. Kevin and Justyna became very friendly and she loved hearing his stories about who lived in our house before us, and what the neighborhood was like before we moved here. Kevin’s yard was immaculate and gorgeous looking. We would joke that one day we’d see him outside with a magnifying glass and scissors making sure his own was perfect.

He used to call Highland Lakes “God’s country”, saying we had our own micro-climate and were a “hidden gem” — he was so proud of living here. He made us proud to call Coon Den Road home, too.

Kevin had a great sense of humor and would frame small annoyances in a way that would make you laugh out loud. I always got a kick when Kevin would call me about how Amazon would mix up the packages for our two houses constantly and we would have to exchange them after we both got home from work.

Kevin was also a driving force behind the annual mum give away on our block, making sure to pick up a bazillion mums from the greenhouse (always the best ones that hadn’t yet opened), so that we could carry on a little Coon Den tradition to bring joy to all the neighbors. He never complained about how much of a pain it must have been to get all those mums and transport them here, because that’s the type of person he was.

Kevin raised two great kids across the street from us, Jennifer and

Dakota, and I know they will miss their dad. The only thing bigger than Kevin's voice was his heart. We will miss him terribly.
