Louis Raimondi, 86, formerly of West Milford, NJ, passed away on Sunday, April 3, 2016 after a short illness.

Louis was born on March 3, 1930 in Brooklyn, NY to Giuseppe and Mary Raimondi.

He was raised in West Milford, NJ and lived there for 70 years before moving to Bedminster, NJ .

Louis proudly served in the United States Army during the Korean War. Upon returning from serving Louis was a self-employed builder and owner of R. Custom Builders of West Milford. He built numerous homes in West Milford and named many roads in this township including West Milford Lakes and Mt. Laurel. He took part in contracting sewer installations in Franklin, NJ (Sussex County).

Louis was a longtime farmer with a turnover of livestock. He was a great educator and willing to teach his trades to many over the years so they would have something to fall back on if things failed in their lives.

Louis was a volunteer for the Special Olympics, Equestrian educator.

He was a member of the West Milford Legion Hall, a longtime, active member

of the Masonic Charity-Congdon Overlook Lodge 163 in Bernardsville, NJ.

Lou's hobbies were flying his private plane, snowmobiling, taking care of his animals, living off the land, and traveling to Italy.

He was predeceased by his wife Gladys A. Raimondi (Storms) and his parents Giuseppe and Mary

Louis is survived by his daughter Lisa Marie Raimondi, of West Milford, NJ, and his Godchildren Larry Van Splinter and Lorraine Sherba (Van Splinter).
