Innately kind and patient with all who entered her gracious path, Marjorie Frances Mellon Anderson, passed away peacefully on August 17, 2019 at her daughter Linda Anderson's home in Greenville, New York following a very hard - fought grace filled effort from a stroke in late February.

Born on September 16, 1930 to Henry and Helen Mellon in Beaver Falls, Pa, Margie loved words, music, flowers and spending time with her friends in downtown Beaver Falls at their favorite drug store gathering place, enjoying the ice cream counter and walking to see movies.
