Roland "Rob" L. Cole, 91, of Newfoundland, passed away at his home on Saturday, January 10, 2015 with his family by his side.

Rob was born on October 23, 1923 in Newfoundland, NJ to Madaline (VanDerhoff) and David Cole.

Rob proudly served in the US Army during WW II in the Alpha Company 726 Battalion.

Rob married Anna May Post in 1942 and together they raised their daughter Quindara in Newfoundland, NJ.

He was the mail carrier at the Newfoundland Post Office delivering for over 33 years to the Green Pond Road residents.

Rob was a lifelong member of the VFW Post 2906 in Pompton Lakes, NJ, and was one of the first volunteer firefighters in the Newfoundland Fire Department.

He was an avid hunter and fisherman but will best be remembered for his extensive gardening, as his neighbors will attest to his fresh produce throughout the years.
