Ronald J. Leba, a devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather and brother, passed away on Tuesday, March 25th 2025 after a bout with cancer.

Everyone who knew him loved him for his contagious spirit, sense of humor, quick wit and endless knowledge of trivia.

Born in Passaic NJ on July 25th 1938 the oldest son of Julius and Julia (Fermango) Leba. One of 4 children, he grew up in Garfield NJ. He joined the U.S. Navy in 1956 and was stationed in Key West FL and Lakehurst NJ where he served as an airship crewman aboard Navy blimps.

After leaving military service, he married his late wife, Patricia (Sciarello) in 1959. They resided in Garfield and started a family before moving to Paterson and then to Toms River after he retired. Several years after Patricia passed, he moved to Franklin, NJ.

Ron worked for many years in the manufacturing industry at Action Technology in Totowa and also in the Industrial Supply business at Singac Supply in Cedar Grove before semi-retiring and working part time as a security guard for Singer Kearfott in West Paterson.

A proud veteran, Ron relished spending time with family and friends. He loved travelling to Florida, visiting historic places, attending sporting events and going camping. He enjoyed good food, having a few beers, playing bingo on Sunday, listening to country music (Johnny Cash!), watching old western movies (John Wayne!), Jeopardy (of which he knew most of the answers!) and

sports especially The WWE, Yankees baseball and Giants football.

Ron was predeceased by his parents, his wife Patricia, brother Julius Leba and brother-in-law Charles Richnavsky.

He is survived by his three children, son Ronald Jr. and his wife Dolores, daughters Cheryl Klapmuts and her husband Harold and Sharon Leba. 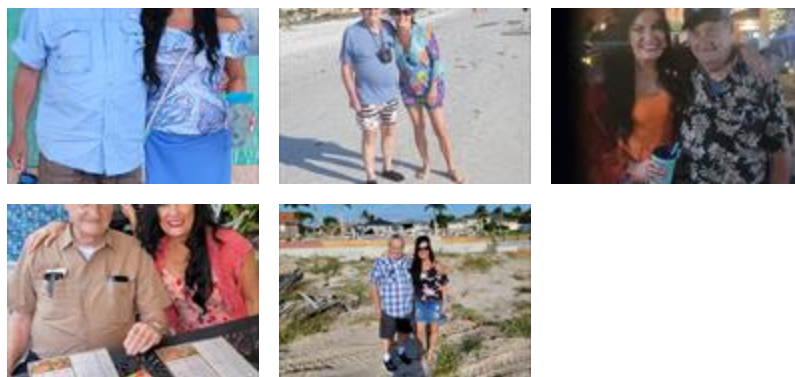
