Vincent D'Antonio, age 92, a resident of Pinecliff Lake, West Milford, NJ for 47 years, passed peacefully in his home with his daughters by his side on September 18th, 2019.

Born to Andrew and Antoinette (Marino) D'Antonio on February 15th, 1927 in Ossining, NY.

As a young man, he served proudly in the United States Army during WWII.

While living in Brooklyn he met and married Lorraine Lacari in 1961. They resided in Flatbush for the next ten years during which they welcomed their first two daughters Kim and Gina, before moving to Pinecliff Lake in 1971. Shortly after happily adding a third daughter, Melissa to the family.

Vincent was a member of the Laborers Union Local 731 for 59 years. He was the epitome of a hard working man, he was a fixture in the community and could be found most mornings at one of the town's delis or diners, enjoying coffee, an egg sandwich and good conversation with fellow locals. In addition, he was a longstanding member of the West Milford Elk's Lodge #2236.

Vincent was predeceased by his wife, Lorraine with whom he enjoyed 49 years of marriage before her untimely passing in 2010, and by his brother Daniel D'Antonio who passed in 1999.

He was a caring father to his daughters Kim Kreston, Gina Dahl and Melissa Shaffer. A respected father-in-law to Craig Dahl and Mark Kreston , and a proud Papa to Ryan and Connor Kreston; Craig, Alex and Matthew Dahl; and Carlie Shaffer. A dear brother-in-law to Mary Ann Dunn, Joanne and Jerry Hines and the late John Lacari as well as a beloved uncle to many nieces and nephews.
