William "Bill" J. Feuss, PhD, 72 years, of Oak Ridge, New Jersey passed away on Wednesday, January 15, 2025.

He was born on August 24, 1952 in Montclair, New Jersey to the late Catherine M. (nee O'Neill) and the late Gerard J. Feuss, Jr.

He graduated from Wayne Valley High School, then went on to Pace University where he received his BS. He continued his education at New York University receiving his MBA. And lastly, Bill attended Steven's Institute of Technology where he received his PhD.

Bill married Donna Dooley in 1976 and resided in Greenwich Village in New York City. In 1979 they moved to Paterson, New Jersey and in 1985 they relocated to Oak Ridge, New Jersey where they remained until his passing.

For the last several years, Bill ran his own business as a Statistical Consultant, William Feuss and Associates in Oak Ridge, New Jersey.

He was an accomplished bassist, playing in many bands, and also sang in the choir of St. Thomas. Upon retiring from AT&T, he enjoyed teaching Statistics in various universities throughout the area.
